Revival Services

5. On motion approved having a Gideon speak at the morning worship service. The pastor will be on vacation.
6. By consent approved E.J. Boyson and Ian Meade filling the pulpit on June 22 to report on their attendance at the General Assembly meeting in Japan. Pastor will lead the service.
7. On motion will retain the IBM stock given for the Building Fund.
8. On motion approved the monthly financial report given by the treasurer and the pastor's monthly allowance report.
9. On motion accepted the Worship Committee report on plans for Father's Day and the FLC Dedication and Revival services.
10. On motion approved the Christian Education committee recommendation of Lana Jo Winn being the VBS director for June 23-27, 2008. Heard a report on possible attendees at Junior and Junior High Camps.
11. After discussing progress for disposal

- of old building approved on motion to formally ask the Harpeth Ridge Fire Department to use it as a training burn, if they desired.
12. On motion approved offering two cottage prayer meetings in preparation for our revival services. Julie Cunningham offered her home for one of them.
 13. Discussed plans for the Dedication Service of the Family Life Center on July 27. We will have special music from an outside person or group, make a video presentation of the building process, will send invitations, and set a budget not to exceed \$500.
 14. By consent we will have a church-wide cleaning day on July 26 with the men furnishing breakfast for all who can come.
 15. Finalized the July church calendar.
 16. Closed in prayer for the church, community and special needs.

We are calling for a church-wide clean-up day for the Family Life Center on Saturday, July 26. The men will furnish a breakfast at 7:30 a.m. A sign-up sheet will be made available.
